WHITES

The different faces of Sauvignon

Sauvignon flourishes in cooler climate regions, but can make a variety of styles. On the one hand we find examples which are more herbaceous with notes of gooseberry and flowering currants, but there are also richer versions, fermented and aged in old barrels, spending a long time on the yeast lees to acquire layers of texture and flavours.

Riesling versus Chenin

Wine is light held together by water (Galileo).

Two very versatile grapes and two varieties that specially capture the nature of the soils and climate in which they are grown. Riesling is particularly fine with smoked fish, whilst Chenin is traditionally matched to salmon and trout.

Skin contact/Orange Wines (from around the world)

"Terroir, after all, lives in the skins". (Mike Weersing) A style of wine that dates back around 8,000 years. Wines which are macerated or fermented on their skins and acquire a hue that varies from gold through orange to amber, in addition to real structure and tannin. Effectively, white wines made in the same spirit as traditional reds. You can drink these with fish, meat and even game.

Oxidative/Sherry/Voile

Wines aged under a “veil” of yeast (also known as flor). Wines such as fino and manzanilla taste yeasty when young and develop rich nutty aromas and deep-spicy flavours with some age in the bottle. The youthful wines are delicious with fried fish and anchovies, more complex versions happily accompany offal and hard cheese.

Vecchio Samperi is more than 40 years old, with the smoky, nutty complexity of a fine sherry. But Vecchio Samperi is unfortified, just as all Marsala was before the British came along towards the end of the 18th century and added spirit to it. The wine (from Grillo grape) is dry, intense and mellow with flavours of chestnuts, Brazil nuts and orange peel. Try it with aged pecorino cheeses, or maybe slightly chilled alongside some shellfish or other seafood as an aperitif. It is a rare treasure in the world of wine and is described by Marco as a “Vino Liquoroso secco”.

Classic Burgundy and Great Chardonnay

Chardonnay expresses the nuances of terroir as well as any grape; the particularities of a vineyard site, which is why Burgundy, with its complex mosaic of soils and microclimates is a natural home for this grape. Chardonnay is also highly adaptable; there are terrific examples from elsewhere in Europe and the New World.
